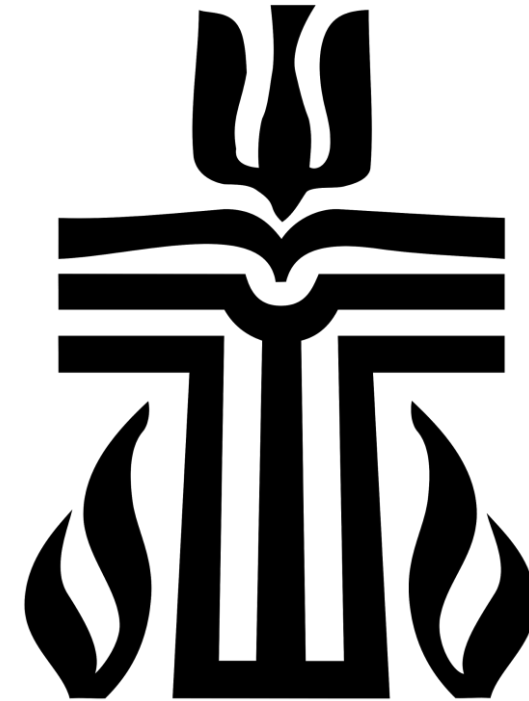
### We pray for those in need during miscellaneous circumstances.
